This year we are supporting All Saints Church who are collecting donations for the Sisters of the Church, Loaves and Fishes Ministry who provide much needed support and care for those who find themselves in challenging circumstances.

We would therefore like all the children to buy or collect from home some non-perishable goods to donate, ideally this is: Packets: Cereals, Pasta, Rice, Instant Soup, Biscuits, Tea Bags and Jars of Coffee. Tins: Tuna, Ham, Stew, Fruit, Rice Pudding, Custard, Beans, Soup and Vegetables. (Please ensure all foods are in date). Also essential toiletries for men and women: Toothbrushes and Toothpaste, Shower Gel and Nappies (larger size)

All donations need to be brought to school on either **Thursday 15th or Friday 16th October** to either the Lower Redland Road or Worrall Road site at your child's usual scheduled drop off time. Due to these challenging times, we require that your child walks in the donations and leaves them in the carrier bags used to carry them in. This will enable us to isolate donations for the recommended 72 hours prior to them being collected and load them onto the collection van easily.

Unfortunately, this year we are unable to hold our whole school Harvest assembly as normal but your children will be taking part in a celebration over Zoom. You always support us so generously and I know that The Sisters of the Church will be extremely grateful for your donations when they receive them.
