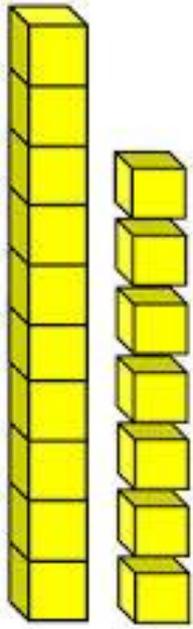


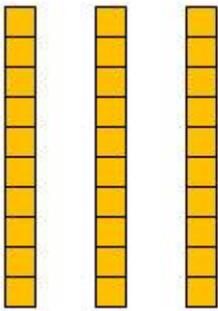
Examples of partitioning 2 digit numbers in to tens and ones

This resource is called Base 10.



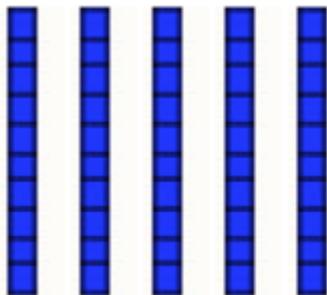
$$= 1 \text{ ten} + 7 \text{ ones}$$

$$= 17$$



$$= 3 \text{ tens} + 4 \text{ ones}$$

$$= 34$$



$$= 5 \text{ tens} + 7 \text{ ones}$$

$$= 57$$



This resource is called Numicon.
