## Planting a Tree

This Sunday, at the All Age Eucharist, we will plant an Oak Tree in the All Saints Gardens. At the end of Mass we'll process out into the garden, plant the tree and then have the blessing and dismissal outside (let's hope for better weather...). Whilst we will have the benefit of watching the tree grow it is already a large sapling – and, if left to its own devices, would be a very large oak tree in about 300 year time.
