Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Topic and English work this term, children in year 5&6 will be given the opportunity to visit Bristol Zoo on Friday 14th February. We will be spending some time exploring the zoo, including thinking about animal habitats, and will then take part in a workshop on Rainforests. Although we are aware that your children may have already visited the zoo a number of times, we are going with a specific focus and much of the work we do in school both before and after will be based around our day at the zoo.

Bristol Zoo currently have a special winter deal which includes both the entrance price as well as an education session for only £7.20, which we will be asking for as a voluntary contribution. If your child is already a member of the zoo, you will only need to pay the workshop cost of £1.70 however your child must bring their membership card with them on the day in order to qualify for the discounted price. As always, we rely on your voluntary contributions to fund these trips so please access ParentMail to give your consent and make your voluntary contribution (by Friday 31st January) and get in touch with your child's class teacher if you are able to help on the day.

Your child will need to wear school uniform with appropriate footwear as well as a warm, waterproof coat as much of the day will be spent outside. Please also send your child in with a packed lunch ensuring that there are no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or nuts.
