Information regarding the Flu Immunisation programme

Please be advised that the e-consent process for the Flu vaccinations will close at midnight two days prior to the first day of immunisations at your school. Parents will not be able to consent for the vaccinations to take place at the school session after this point.

In order to maximise the uptake of the vaccines we will be offering community clinics for students who have missed their vaccination in school for any reason i.e. not having returned consent forms, if parents have not completed their e-consent forms, or if students were absent on the day of the session. Schools will be sent information to send to parents regarding how to book these additional clinics.

Please only give the paper forms out if parents are unable to access the internet, the paper forms will delay the sessions as they will need to be triaged on the day of the session.

We will send you, the afternoon prior to the first session, a list of students who have consented to the vaccinations and need to be brought to the vaccination room in order to enable you to schedule the session and to try and reduce disruption to the school as far as possible.
