Whole School	Wed 20 Jul	All parents are invited to the End of Year Service , if you attend you will be able to take your child home directly from the church at 2.45pm. Volunteer walkers will be required to walk to and from All Saints, please talk to your class teacher if you are able to help. Please note the main entrance is closed so you will need to enter through the side door, you will not be able to enter once the service has started.
Whole School	Thu 21 Jul	There is a special Leavers Day menu available to pupils. Please note, Parentpay will not reflect these new choices on that date, so to order, please choose the meat option, or the vegetarian option or the halal option. Jacket potatoes and tomato pasta can NOT be ordered on that day.
Whole School	Tue 19 Jul	The date for your diary for booking Shine Clubs is next Tuesday 19th July at 12:30pm . All clubs are first come first served. Two Term Booking: You are now able to book for 2 terms, taking you from September through to December. The programme for January onwards will be open for booking in December, with further details sent nearer the time. Reception Children: Children in Reception are welcome to come to My Time when they are in school full time. There will be more clubs open to them, including wraparound care hours, after Christmas. Holiday Clubs: Are running all summer, including Friday 22nd July.
Whole School		Given the extreme heat forecast please pay special attention to applying sun cream to your child before arriving at school and providing a hat and water bottle every day. Children may wear their PE kit instead of school uniform as this may be cooler.
Whole School	Mon 18th	Send children into school with a spare bag, so that they can use it for the books/work that is being sent home at the end of term.
EYFS	Mon 18 Jul	Children can bring water play clothes and a towel to school, they may also bring one water pistol or water play toy.
EYFS	Thu 21 July	All EYFS parents are welcome to come and watch the video of the children's end of year songs with the children in the hall as a celebration of your child's first year at school. If you also have a child at Worrall Road you are welcome to take your EYFS child at 3:10. We will dismiss the rest of the children from their classrooms at 3:30 as normal. If you are unable to come along, a link to the video will be available afterwards.
