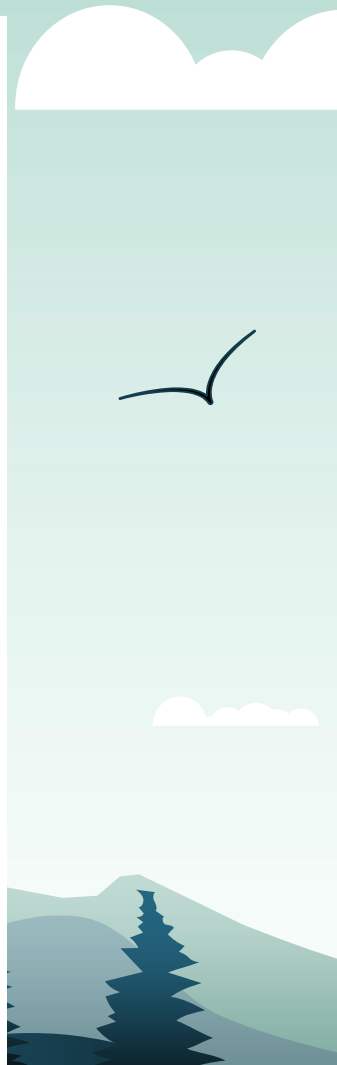

One case / holdall per child, **plus** a backpack that will carry a named water bottle and anything they require to keep them busy on the coach.

Your child needs to be able to carry all of their luggage by themselves.

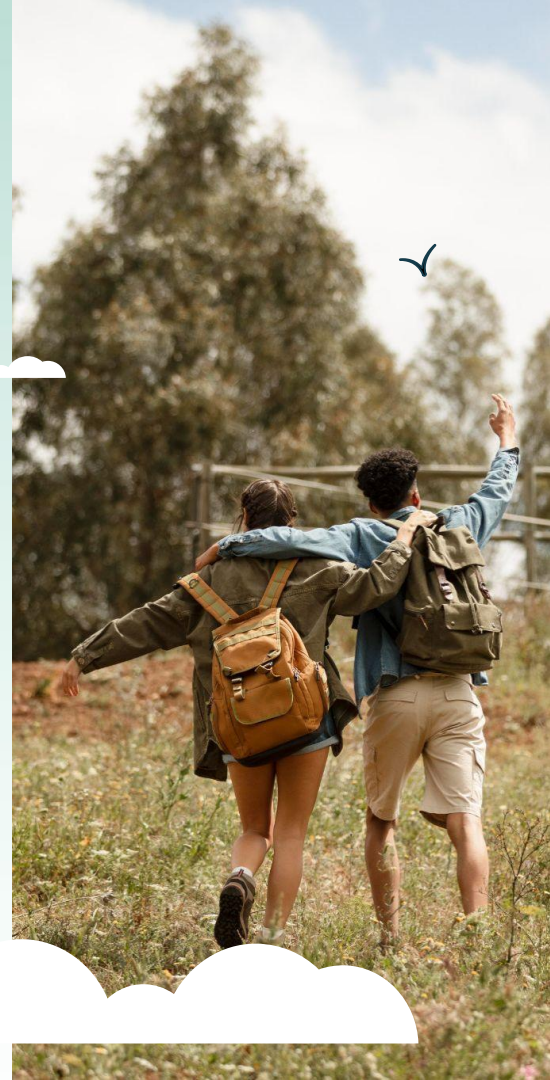
Logistics
