PAYMENT (ParentMail)	Total cost: £200. Total balance is now due.
STAFF	Miss Sarah-Jo Scarborough will lead the residential along with Miss Ellie Dixey and 4 other members of staff. PGL also has its own trained resident staff onsite.
MEDICAL/ DIETARY NEEDS	We will take the medication currently signed in by parent/carers that is kept at school (please still include these details on the medical form). However, if your child requires any form of additional medication during the visit, please sign the medicine in at the Worrall Road office by Monday 18 th March. A parent/carer must sign in this medication, we cannot accept it from a child. If your child is likely to be travel sick, give them tablets before they travel on Monday and give the Worrall road office a tablet for the return journey (named box or envelope) by Wednesday 20 th March. ALL MEDICATION MUST BE IN THE ORIGINAL BOX WITH THE INFORMATION LEAFLET. WE WILL NOT TAKE OVER THE COUNTER MEDICINE THIS INCLUDES ANY HAY FEVER MEDICATION. WE WILL ONLY TAKE MEDICATION PERSCRIBED BY THE DOCTOR.
SUPERVISION	All children will be carefully supervised at all times. It is vital that all children follow the instructions from the staff onsite. Please ensure parent/carers have reinforced this message to their children prior to the residential to ensure a safe and happy few days.

EMERGENCIES	01497 847 696: - this telephone number is for emergencies only. This is the center's number. Please contact the Worrall Road office in any instance first. In case of an emergency Miss Scarborough will contact you or pass a message via school. If your child is asked to return for disciplinary reasons you will be contacted immediately and it will be necessary for you to make arrangements to collect your child.
FOOD AND DRINK	All meals are provided for the children. You may wish to pack a couple of snacks. All children will need a water bottle. (<u>no glass bottles or cans please and NO NUTS</u>).
DEPARTURE	It is planned that we will leave by coach at 9:30am on Monday 25 th March. Please therefore arrive at school at normal time and bring your children to the hall.
RETURN	The children will arrive back at school on Wednesday afternoon at approximately 3:30pm (Depending on traffic). We shall email you via ParentMail during the afternoon to update you if there is a change in the expected time of arrival. Please do not call the office to check arrival times we will send out any updates via ParentMail. The children will walk back to the school and will be dismissed by a school adult once back in the playground.

Equipment / Clothing List

The following is a list of items which your child will require to take with them on the Year 4 residential. We will spend all of our time outside apart from meal times and sleeping so waterproofs are essential and lots of spare socks! It is helpful that your child knows what is packed in their bag as this will help when we pack up to come home. Putting their name in their clothes would be so incredibly helpful.
