

## **Performance Data Year 6 2023-24**

At St. John's we are exceptionally proud of all our children's achievements across a range of areas. An important element of our children's success is captured in their performance in statutory assessments in Reading, Writing and Mathematics at the end of Year 6. Cohorts are different year on year and so our results do also vary depending on the number of children on the Special Educational Needs and Disability register or those new to our school with English as an additional language.

**Attainment:** In each subject, children are aiming to meet the expected standard by achieving a score of at least 100. Children achieving a score of 110 or more are deemed to be higher achievers. Nationally, only 8% of children achieve the higher standard in all subjects (Reading, Writing and Maths).

**Progress:** In the past, we have achieved higher than average progress, often significantly, across all subjects. Due to Covid, there is not currently any progress measure as children did not undertake the SATs in Year which is used as a baseline.

In 2024, our children achieved the following results:
