**Egyptian Gods - Top Trumps**

Using the examples as ideas and this website to find the information, make your own Top Trumps cards for 2 or 3 other Egyptian Gods.

Your card should include all the elements of the examples below, including a drawing. Try to write in your own words and pick the numbers based on what you have read about the God.

**..... Anubis .....**

God of the Dead and Embalming

Popularity	55
Strength	75
Kindness	40
Intelligence	60
Danger	80

Anubis is usually shown with the head of a jackal. He wrapped and embalmed Osiris's body when he was killed and was often associated with funerals.

**..... Ra .....**

God of the Sun

Popularity	90
Strength	100
Kindness	55
Intelligence	80
Danger	60

Ra was one of the most important gods to Egyptians and is often shown with the head of a falcon and a sun disc above. It was believed he sailed the skies during the day and travelled to the underworld at night.

**Decorative Jewellery**
