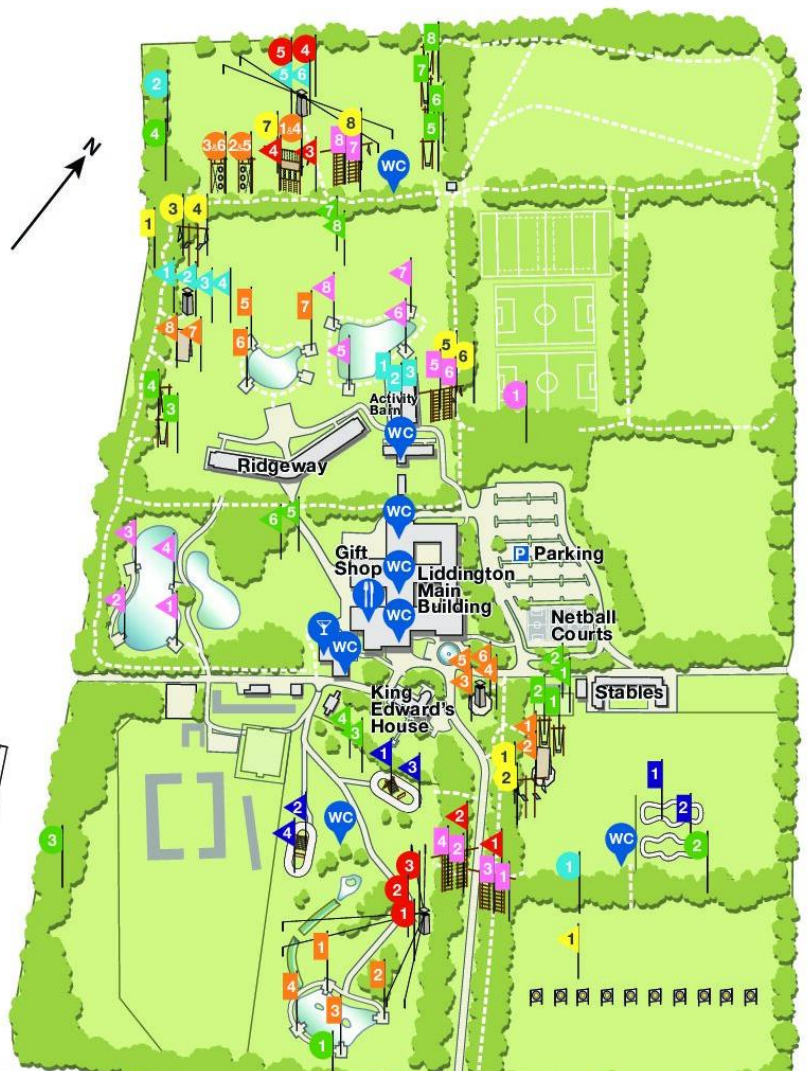
# A big centre for big adventures!

# Logistics

## Monday Morning

# Kit List

In case of an emergency Mr. Hughes will contact you or pass a message via school. If your child is asked to return for disciplinary reasons you will be contacted immediately and it will be necessary for you to make arrangements to collect your child.
