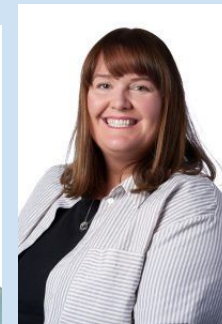

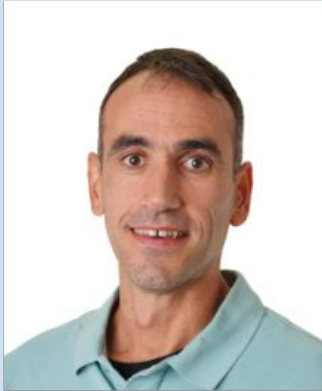

# Independence

  - Walking to and from school and having phones. Please make sure permission slips are completed for this and children are following school rules.

- 'Please encourage not 'do' homework with children; add comments to show any support.
