World Book Day

In line with the arrival of the Book Fair, this year we will be celebrating World Book Day on Friday 6th March. Please note that this is a **day later** than the National World Book Day. This year, our theme will be 'adjectives' so children are invited to come to school **dressed as an adjective**. For example, a child could come to school dressed as the word 'colourful' and wear as many different colours as they have in their wardrobe. Equally, if a child would still like to dress up as a character and wear their batman onesie, their adjective could be 'heroic'. We have added some ideas on the page below to help.

Writing Competition

This year, we are excited to be launching a whole-school writing competition based on the theme "**The Most...**". Children can choose what they create – it could be a labelled picture, a narrative, a poem or non-chronological report—the choice is completely theirs. Example titles could be: the most enormous creature; the most disgusting meal; the most beautiful place; the most terrifying storm; the most magical object etc..

The only rule is that every entry must be titled "**The Most...**" and should use descriptive language to bring their ideas to life. This is a lovely opportunity for children to be creative and show off their writing at their own level. There will be a £5 book token prize for **the winner and runner-up in each joint year group** to spend at the Book Fair. Entries can be handwritten or typed - please send to Mrs Allen (EYFS-Y2) or Miss Potter (Y3-6) by 5th March. Winners will be revealed in assembly on World Book Day.

Finally, your child should come home today with a World Book Day voucher. We highly recommend getting to a bookshop over half term to pick up your free book. They can also be used at the Book Fair to get £1 off any book (only one voucher per child) however we won't stock the free books.
